No wonder that people don't always get the best deal for their gas and electricity. Price comparison websites offer the chance to see what the various energy companies charge. For example:

If you are on a fixed-term deal you can switch without having to pay an exit fee provided you notify your supplier on or before the date any increase or change is due to come into effect.

With average dual fuel bills at around £1,000 per household it really is worth the effort to **SHOP AROUND.**

Co-op Energy might be worth looking at. They offer just one tariff, have simple to understand bills and offer membership points.

Before you switch, do look at standing charges. What looks like a great deal may not be so good, especially if you are a low energy user.

The amount paid by the energy companies will be reviewed for April 2012. For systems installed and commissioned before 31st March you get 43.3p for each kWh generated and 3.1p/pkWh for export. This price is guaranteed for 25 years and is index-linked. Talk to us for further unbiased information.

News from the Churches

The **Vatican** has added its voice to a rising chorus of warnings from churches around the world that climate change and abuse of the environment is against God's will, and that the one billion-strong Catholic church must become far greener.

Islam teaches Muslims to respect Allah's creation and maintain the balance He created. Allah commands people, 'Do not cause corruption on the earth' (2:11). Everyone in the world needs to help. Muslims make up at least one fifth of the world's population.

While most Muslim countries are poor and use far less fossil fuels than rich ones, Muslims in the rich countries are urged to play their part in reducing their consumption of fossil fuels.

Shrinking the Footprint is the **Church of England's** national strategic campaign to enable its members and institutions to address - in faith, practice, and mission - the pressing issue of climate change. It aims to challenge, encourage and support the whole body of the Church to shrink our environmental footprint to create "The 40% Church".

Affordable Warmth Champions

We now have two specially trained volunteers in the area who have the knowledge to assist those in genuine Fuel Poverty (having to spend at least 10% of available income on heating.) We can supply details of who they are.

Did you know?

The average home uses 15,000kWh of gas and 3,300kWh of electricity per year.

Here's how much carbon is emitted into the atmosphere:

Energy Source	Kg of carbon per unit
Grid electricity	0.54 per kWh
Natural Gas	0.18 per kWh of heat
Heating Oil	0.24 per kWh of heat
Diesel	2.67 per litre
Petrol	2.32 per litre
Coal	2336.5 per tonne
Wood pellets	0.038 per tonne
Drinking water	0.59g of carbon per litre

One tonne of carbon will fill a balloon 10m across. The average individual in Shropshire is responsible for 8.63 tonnes of carbon emissions per year.
