- The climate change emergency has not gone away – it continues to get ever more urgent

- The present Government Renewable Heat incentive which over several years will pay for most of the cost of an air source heat pump to replace an oil or gas boilers has been extended until Spring 2022

- Ever wider range of electric car models available, running costs as much as a third of petrol or diesel vehicles, new sales of which could be banned by 2035
- A week's holiday in Tenerife for two costs around £1700 – 14 solar P.V. panels which could halve annual electricity bills and cut CO₂ costs about £4,500. Equivalent to less than three such holidays!
